We have a number of historical portraits of Fairview people whose names we do not know. There are items on display that have unknown origins, uses, and histories.

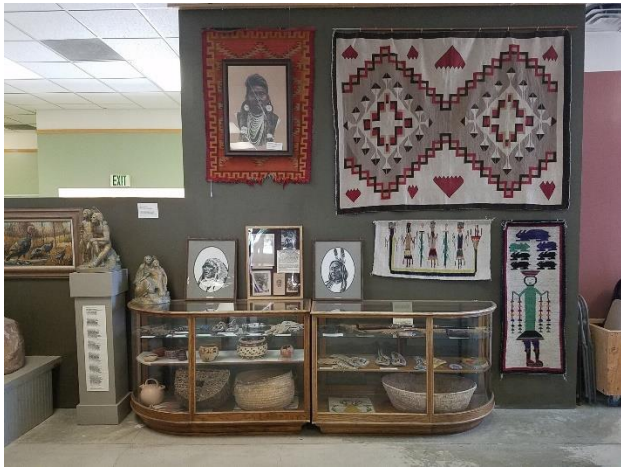
You may also find stories and quizzes.

The Native American artifacts area in the Horizon Building has been reorganized and expanded. Some historical information has been added as well.

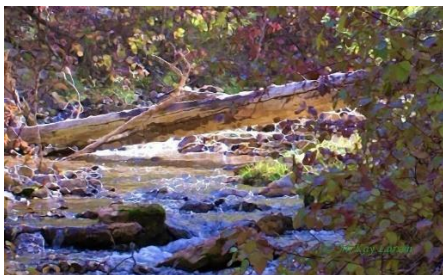
A new display of African artifacts can be found on the first floor of the Horizon Building, next to the history library.

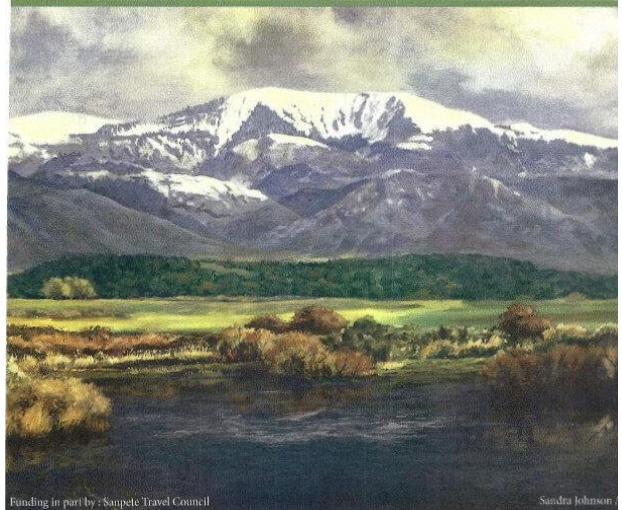
